Young Leaders Studio

This intimate and interactive discussion gives the audience insight into the philosophies and best practices of our featured guest. This event is designed to bring all Young Leaders together to meet and network in an informal setting.

YLG Mentoring Program

The mission of the mentoring program is to foster an exchange of professional ideas, friendship, and expertise among young real estate professionals and industry veterans. This program matches young professionals with experienced professionals for guidance and support, while offering mentors an opportunity to strengthen ties with the young future leaders of the local real estate community and ULI.

Each mentor group shall consist of two to four ULI members under the age of 35, with interest or experience in a similar product type or sector. Each group is led by one mentor. Mentor groups are expected to meet four times in one year starting in January. Meetings can include lessons learned from mentors' careers, discussion of career goals, case studies, social events, project tours, guest speakers, or anything else mutually agreed upon to further the relationship within the group.

Learn From the Best

The premise for LFTB is simple: take 35 Young Leaders and seven regional real estate leaders, place them in groups of five to seven, and let them have a conversation for 15 minutes about informal topics such as tips on success, personal anecdotes, the state of the industry, tricks of the trade, trends, etc. Young Leaders rotate tables a total of seven times, allowing for a broad mix of insights. The result is a mutually rewarding experience, but one that primarily allows the next generation of real estate professionals to learn from recognized industry leaders.

ULI/Gerald D. Hines Student Urban Design Competition

ULI's national competition consisting of teams participating from colleges and universities in the United States and Canada. In addition to competing nationally, the student teams from local universities and colleges will have a unique opportunity, initiated by ULI Columbus, to compete for scholarships and awards against their fellow colleagues on a local level as well.
